

CARBON FOOTPRINT ARCADE BEAUTY EUROPE


A carbon footprint is a necessary and voluntary environmental approach. The principle is to quantify the amount of tonnes of CO2 produced by an industrial activity. It allows seeing if the energy reducing actions are effectively reducing the carbon footprint of the plant.

The following data relate to the 3 locations of Arcade Beauty Europe:

SOCOPLAN: packaging activitiesSOCOPRINT: printing activities

- BIOPACK: packaging activities

SCOPE 1 relates to direct emissions (ex: fuel, gas...) and **SCOPE 2** relates to indirect emissions (ex: electricity...)

Year	2014	2016	2016 VS 2014 (%)
SCOPE 1 (t CO2)	855	1135	+33%
SCOPE 2 (t CO2)	349	379	+9%
TOTAL (t CO2)	1204	1514	+26%

Globally, the carbon footprint increased because of the production volume which has been increasing by +11% between 2014 and 2016. In addition, we observe a decrease of the batch sizes which cause an increase of the amount of energy needed to produce.

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
